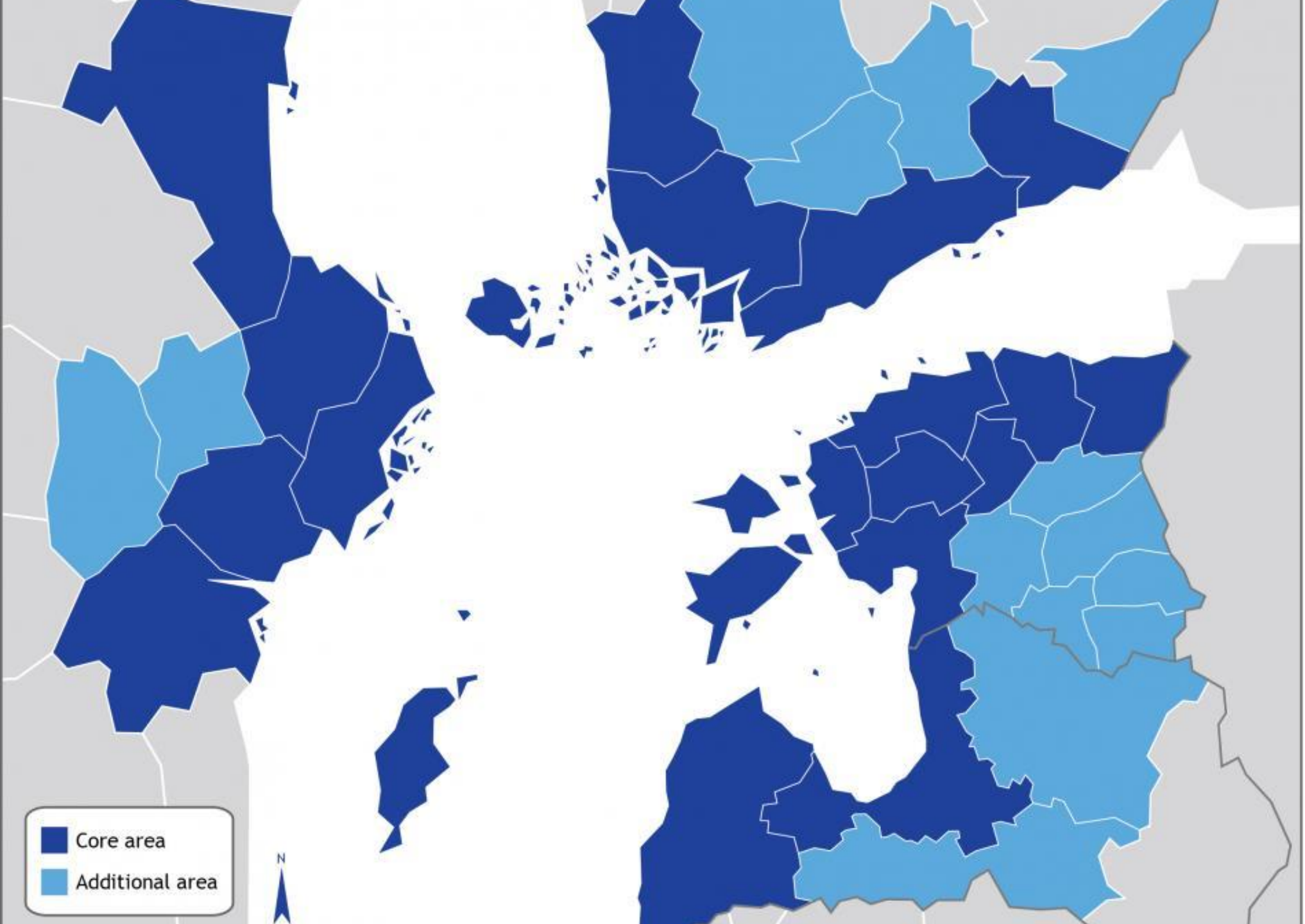

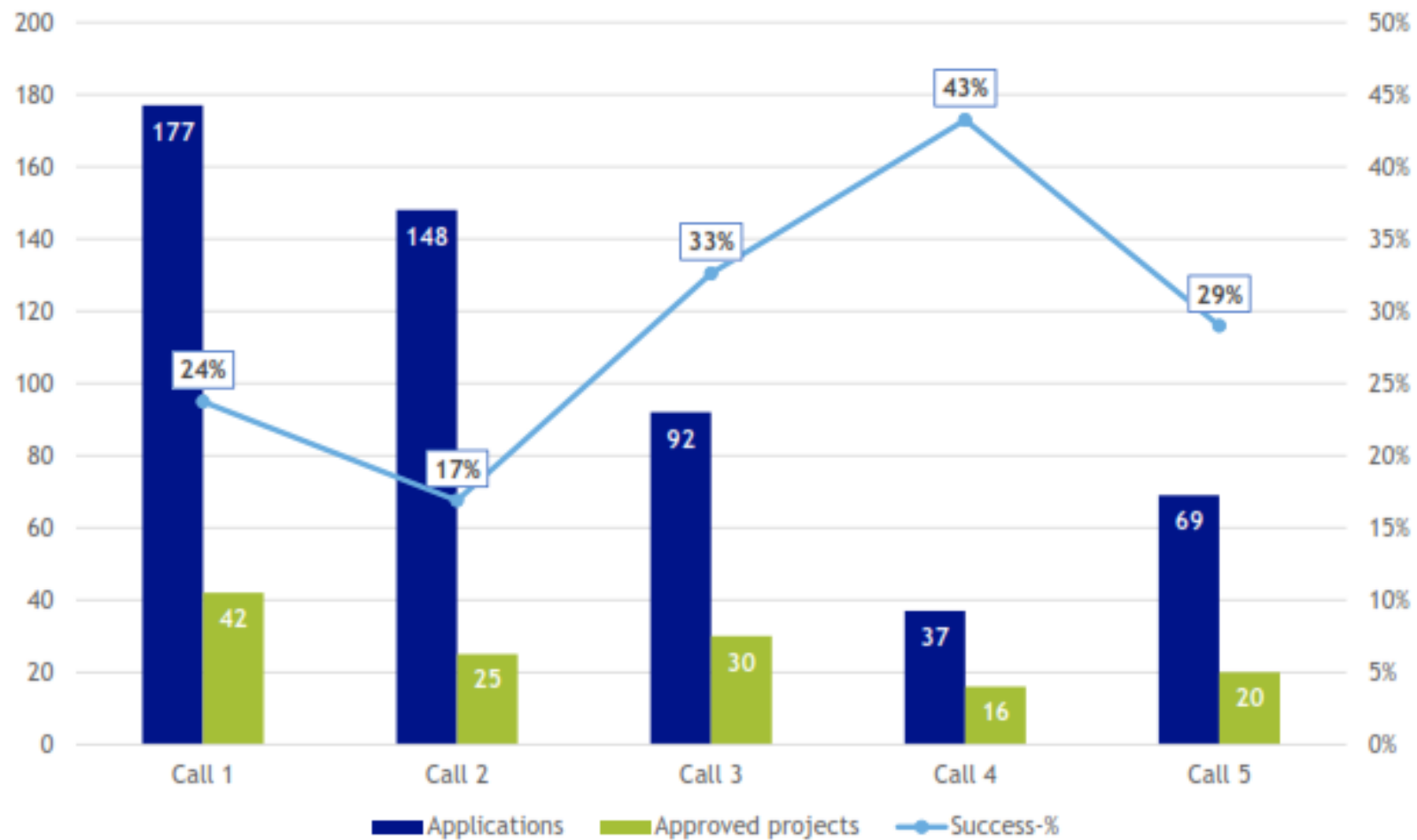


# Central Baltic programme

- ❑ Interreg – 30 years of EU cooperation
- ❑ 20 projects approved in the 5<sup>th</sup> round, 69 applications
- ❑ Our project - April 1<sup>st</sup> 2020 – Sept 30<sup>th</sup> 2022 (activities shall end June 30<sup>th</sup> 2022)

# Shortly the aims

- 5 implementation periods (1<sup>st</sup> April-Sept 2020) each period 6 months
- 80 students involved from 15 schools, 20 teachers trained (27 in Estonia, 27 in Finland, 27 in Latvia, 7 teachers in EE and FIN, 6 in LV, 5 schools involved in each country)
- 20 mentors involved into design of business ideas, support of the participants
- 5 cross-border companies and 7 business simulations implemented



# Shortly the aims

- 30 articles in the media (10-12 in each country)
- 10 events where the participants would acquire inspiration (3-4 in each country)
- Public information seminars
- Matchmaking event when training have been implemented and the business idea phase is taking place
- Project webpage, facebook site, logo, visual identity



# Timeline

- 1<sup>st</sup> period
- 2<sup>nd</sup> period (Oct 2020 – March 2021) Teacher training
- 3<sup>rd</sup> period (April-Sept 2021) Students training
- 4<sup>th</sup> period (Oct 2021 – March 2022) Business ideas, mentoring
- 5<sup>th</sup> period (April-June 2022) guidelines as outcome, companies established and simulations implemented
- last 3 months activities have to be completed
